FENTANYL the ZOMBIE DRUG

Europe In Europe, the European Monitoring Centre for Drugs and Drug Addiction has reported a significant increase in the availability of Fentanyl and its illegal derivatives, such as fentanyl and acetylfentanyl, which have caused numerous poisonings and deaths. In 2021, there were 137 deaths associated with Fentanyl in EU member states.

Prevention measures To combat the misuse of Fentanyl, the Italian Council of Ministers has implemented a national prevention plan. This plan includes awareness campaigns, addiction treatment programs, and measures to limit access to Fentanyl.
